Saskia is a Dutch-American sociologist noted for her analyses of globalization and international human migration. She is Robert S. Lynd Professor of Sociology at Columbia University and Centennial visiting Professor at the London School of Economics. Sassen coined the term global city. Her book *The Global City* has shaped the concepts and methods that other theorists have used to analyze the role of cities and their networks in the contemporary world. During this webinar we tie into the topical debate on how infrastructure and infrastructure service provision could be more actively steered towards the creation of social value for society (fostering a more inclusive society).
