DESIGNING FUTURE CITIES FOR WELLBEING

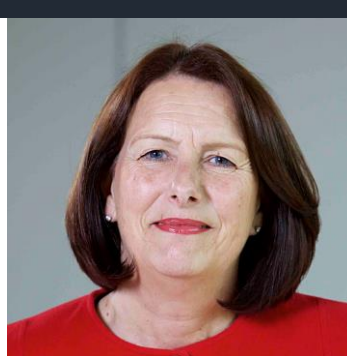

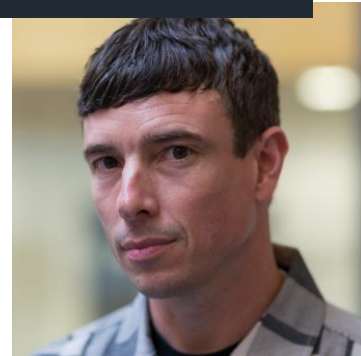
